Cavalry State Tune-Up Rules

- 1-Admissions will be taken at all gates each day for non players and coaches. Players must be in uniform and coaches must have passes.
Adult's \$5/day and Children 6-17 \$3/day on Saturday and Sunday. In the case of Friday games admissions will be adult's \$3 and children free.**
- 2-Your team must be registered with Amateur Softball Association and you must have proof of registry.**
- 3-The tournament format is for each team to play 3 pool play games and advance to single elimination tournament on Sunday. The tournament director has the right to change this format due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.**
- 4-The tournament director may change formats, game times and/or locations at any time.**
- 5-Please check in 45 minutes prior to your first game. Please have proof of registrations and player ages available upon request.**
- 6-Pool play may begin on Friday and continue through Saturday. All pool play games are 75 minute time limit, no inning will start after 75 minutes. Finish the inning unless the home team is leading the game. Pool play games may end in a tie.**
- 7-Tournament games are 7 inning or 75 minute time limit. After 7 innings or 75 minutes in case of a tie score the international tie breaker rule will be in effect.**
- 8-Home teams decided by coin flip in pool play. The higher seed (lower number) is home team for single elimination games.**
- 9-Run rules in effect as 12 runs after 3 innings, 10 runs after 4 innings and 8 runs after 5 innings.**
- 10-Tournament seeding is 1-record, 2-head to head, 3- runs allowed, 4-coin flip.**
- 11-Team awards will be given for each age division for the first, second and third place teams. Individual awards will be given an "all tournament" team as voted by the coaches of each game.**
- 12-Please help keep Hackberry Park clean by picking up your mess as well as one more item. There are no pets allowed at Hackberry Park as well as no alcohol.**
- 13-Cavalry softball Association, Inc. and the City of Wahoo are not responsible for injuries or lost or stolen property.**
- 14-In case of inclement weather please be available at the phone numbers provided on the registration form.**
- 15-Coaches are responsible for their actions as well as their players and fans. Please read and follow all park regulations.**
- 16-Umpires are registered by ASA and their decisions are final! Only roster and age verification protests will be allowed. Protests must be accompanied by \$100 check for official protest.**
- 17-All rules of ASA in effect unless stated in this information.**
